

LIFT TEAM (over 18's only)



RESPONSIBLE TO: Lift Team Leader

VENUE DESCRIPTION:

Lift has a full street course, mini-ramp, beginners course and also incorporates a chill out area. However, Lift is more than a skate park. Lift is about God reaching young people where they're at. Lift is one of the most exciting venues on site; it is also one of the busiest. Team members must understand that it is amazing fun serving God in this way, but Lift is about serving not skating. We value a servant heart more than an experienced skater. This means that being part of the Lift team in any capacity, skating, blading, BMX-ing or working in the café is fun but hard work.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Be able to chat with the young people attending Lift building up relationships with them, and if necessary identify those with specific needs, who are being disruptive, who are carrying drink, drugs etc. Report all such cases to your Team Leader.
- To pray for delegates, under the direction of the ministry team leaders, in the event main meetings.
- If applying for the skate team you should have an interest in skating/blading and enough ability to be able to teach a beginner the very basics.
- Be willing to adapt to take on roles as needed, eg serving drinks and refreshments, keeping the venue clean and tidy at all times.
- Under the direction of the Team Leader adhere to Health and Safety regulations; maintain the appearance of the venue; take responsibility for security in the venue.
- Be able to recognise and liaise with First Aid, Detached and Steward teams when and where necessary.
- Any matter for discipline to be referred to the Team Leader.
- Experience in First Aid is preferable but not essential – **Please note on your application if you are a qualified first aider.**
- Report all disclosures of past and present abuse of any nature to your Team Leader. Do not promise confidentiality.
- Discuss with the Team Leader any delegate's wanting/needing any involved ministry.

CONCESSIONS: Lift Team members receive a free pass and are provided with 3 meals a day. Your first meal will be an evening meal the first day of the event (Day 1) and your last meal will be in the evening of the last day of the event (Day 5). But you are responsible for providing your own accommodation.

CONDITIONS

- ***Soul Survivor* has outlined certain Values & Principles for ministry, which should be read and understood. Whilst on a team at *Soul Survivor*, you are expected to accept and work out of these values at all times.**
- **You should attend all appropriate team meetings during the event.**
- **You must be 18 years or over.**

There will be a Team meeting on your day of arrival, which you MUST attend. Successful applicants will be sent details of where and when this Team meeting will take place at a later date.
